DAY WISE SHORT ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival

TBA Landing at Tbilisi International Airport. Clearing immigration and customs. Collecting the baggage.

Meeting with the representative in the arrivals hall and transfer to the hotel

Assistance with check-in at the hotel (standard time – 14:00-15:00). Free time to freshen up

Overnight in Tbilisi

Day 2 : Two Capitals – Tbilisi and Mtskheta

Breakfast at the hotel. at about 10:00 am – Firstly, we will drive to Mtskheta, which is ancient capital of Georgia and one of the most important spiritual and cultural centers of country.

Visit Jvari Monastery and Svetitkhoveli Cathedral there. Then, we will visit the Chronicle of Georgia in Tbilisi and survey surroundings.

Later, will drive to the OLD TBILISI and start the walking tour to discover the beauty of ancient capital – walking tour starts at the Europe Square and includes: Metehki Church, Cable Car to the Narikala fortress (ride up by cable car), "Mother of Kartli", walking down to Abano District.

Free time there for photo shooting. Walking on Rustaveli Avenue. Then shopping at Flea market and Gallery Mall.

Overnight in Tbilisi

Day 3: Tour to Kakheti Region

Breakfast at the hotel. At about 10:00 am – We will drive to Kakheti Region which is also known as the “Cradle of Wine”, because of its world known history and technology of wine making and unique sorts of grapes. On the way, in village Badiauri, we will taste the delicious local Bread and Cheese. Later, we will visit the “City of Love” – Sighnaghi. A beautiful town is situated on the top of the hill, surrounded by valleys and huge Caucasus Mountains. Visit the nunnery of Bodbe. Return to Tbilisi. Upon request, guests can visit the KTW Winery and have a wine tasting. On the way back to Tbilisi we will visit the Ujarma Castle.

Overnight in Tbilisi

Day 4: Tour to Gudauri and Kazbegi

Breakfast at the hotel. At about 09:00 am (!) – Start the tour of Mtskheta-Tianeti Region. Visit Ananuri Complex and Jinali Dam. Continue driving to Gudauri and stop at the Monument, which is good viewpoint for photo shooting. If weather conditions permit, we will drive to Kazbegi and change the transport to 4x4 vehicle there and ride up to Gergeti Trinity.

Returning to Tbilisi.

If weather conditions DO NOT permit – we will have free time in Gudauri to enjoy the snow activities.

Overnight in Tbilisi

Day 5: Sadakhlo – Dilijan – Sevan – Yerevan City tour

Breakfast at the hotel. At about 09:00 am (!) – Drive to Sadakhlo border

Meet at Sadakhlo border. Transfer to Dilijan. Dilijan, often referred to as the “Switzerland of Armenia,” is a picturesque spa town nestled in the lush forests of Tavush Province. Renowned for its serene landscapes, rich cultural heritage, and vibrant arts scene, Dilijan offers a unique blend of natural beauty and historical significance. Then drive to Lake Sevan. The road will take you to Lake Sevan. Here, in Lake Sevan, which has a very beautiful peninsula, we are going to climb many stairs up to see the church located in the peak – Sevanavank, from where opens also a beautiful view to the “blue-eyed” lake. Drive to Yerevan. We will continue Yerevan Sightseeing City tour, including City center, Mother Armenia Monument with a panoramic view over the city, Republic square, endowed by singing and dancing fountains, Opera house, Northern Avenue, Cascade Complex. Overnight in Yerevan.

Day 6: Yerevan – Garni – Geghard – Symphony of Stones – Yerevan

After breakfast at the hotel drive to the unique caved temple St. Geghard (12th -13th cc.), the name of which means “holy spear” in the honor of the same spear that pierced the body of crucified Jesus Christ. It is now exhibited in the museum of Etchmiadzin Cathedral on the way to the short Photo stop at Charents Arc. Visit the only remaining pagan temple in Armenia devoted to the God of Sun – Myrth, Garni, built in 77 AD by King Trdat. Drive Symphony of Stones – a natural monument located in the basin of the Azat River consists of huge symmetric hexagon and pentagon basalt columns (nearly 50 meters high), which seem to

be handmade due to their amazing symmetry also referred to as “Basalt Organ Pipes”.
Overnight in Yerevan.

Day 7: Departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out formalities (standard time – 12:00). Transfer to Zvartnots International Airport (3-3.5 hours prior to departure flight)

Visa on Arrival:

- Passport must be valid for more than 6 months and QID must be valid for minimum 3 months after return date.
