Attractions in Jordan

Madaba: Northwest of the Roman street in Madaba you arrive to the Greek Orthodox Church of St George built in the 19th century housing the unique mosaic map dating to the 6th century AD that was uncovered in 1884. It represents a topographical source of Byzantine Jordan, Palestine and lower Egypt.



Mt. Nebo: Mount Nebo is the highest point in the ancient Kingdom of Moab, referenced in Abrahamic texts as the site of Mount Nebo this township was



first inhabited by a Christian nomadic tribe in the 4th century.

Kerak: Whether you approach Karak from the ancient Kings Highway to the east or from the Dead Sea to the west, the striking silhouette of this fortified The town and castle will instantly make you understand why the fates of kings and nations were decided here for millennia.

Petra: The ancient city of Petra is one of Jordan's national treasures and by far its best-known tourist attraction. Petra is the legacy of the Nabataeans, an industrious Arab people who settled in southern Jordan more than 2,000 years ago

Wadi Rum: "The Valley of the Moon", depicted as Mars in several Hollywood



feature films Wadi Rum is an Arabian fairy tale waiting to be discovered.

Dead Sea: A spectacular natural wonder, the Dead Sea, located 427 meters



below sea level, is perfect for wellness tourism and family fun in the sun.

Jerash: the ancient city of Jerash boasts an unbroken chain of humans

Occupations dating back more than 6,500 years and are only about 45km north of Amman and Because of its water the site has been settled at least since Neolithic times.

Ajloun: more formally known as Qal'at Ar-Rabad, towers above the green hills of Ajloun and can be seen from many miles away, betraying its strategic purpose as a military watch post that protected the trade routes in the 12th-15th centuries

Desert Castles: Named Al-Harrana Castle as it is positioned in the Al-Harrana

Valley. The square fortress was resurrected during the reign of Al Walid ibn Abd al-Malik – Qasr **Amrah**: uilt during the reign of the Umayyad caliph Yazid bin Abd alMalik, who is considered to be the sixth caliph of the Umayyad successors, Quseir Amra is believed to have been a location to aid in hunting.

Day 1

Begin your day with a visit to Madaba, home of the famous mosaic map at St. George's Church. Then, travel to Mt. Nebo, where you'll stand at the spot believed to be where Moses saw the Promised Land. Continue to Kerak, where you'll explore its impressive Crusader castle. Finally, head south to Petra, where you'll spend the night after a day of rich history and exploration, ready to uncover Petra's secrets the next day.

Day 3

PETRA - PETRA VISIT - PETRA

After breakfast, you will marvel at the beauty of the 'Lost City', the Red Rose City of Petra, exploring its many caves and tombs. Walk through the canyon and be astounded at the magnificent Treasury, the entrance guarding the ancient Nabatians city, now one of the Modern 7 Wonders of the World.

PETRA - WADI RUM

Breakfast & check out, We head further down in southern Jordan to visit other significant site called Wadi Rum. Explore Wadi Rum on a 2-hour jeep ride into the Jordanian desert! Wadi Rum was best described by T.E. Lawrence as "Vast, echoing and god-like", and by the locals as "Valley of the Moon", Check in at Camp Dinner and overnight stay in Wadi Rum Camp
