DAY WISE TENTATIVE ITINERARY

DAY- 1 ARRIVAL IN BAKU – TRANSFER TO HOTEL- CHECK IN

- Arrival at Heydar Aliyev International Airport and meet & greet our representative.

- Transfer to the hotel
- Assistance with check-in at the hotel (standard time – 14:00–15:00).
- Free time to freshen up and overnight in Baku.

DAY– 2 ENJOY BAKU CITY TOUR

- Breakfast in Hotel
- Our tour program starts with **Old City** or **Icheri Sheher**, the historical core of Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan. The Old City is the most ancient part of Baku, which is surrounded by walls and is well protected. In 2007, the Old City had a population of about 3000 people. In December 2000, the Old City of Baku, including the Palace of the Shirvanshahs and Maiden Tower (Giz Galasi), became the first location in Azerbaijan to be classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. (Walking tour)
- The tour continues with the visit to the charming example of modern architecture – **The Heydar Aliyev Center** – a 57,500 m² building complex in Baku, Azerbaijan designed by Iraqi British architect Zaha Hadid and noted for its distinctive architecture and flowing, curved style that eschews sharp angles. The center is named after Heydar Aliyev, the first secretary of Soviet Azerbaijan from 1969 to 1982, and president of Azerbaijan Republic from October 1993 to October 2003. (Photo shoot outside)
- Walking through **Baku Boulevard** which stretches along a south-facing bay on the Caspian Sea. It traditionally starts at Freedom Square, continuing west to the Old City and beyond. Since 2012, the Yeni Bulvar (New Boulevard) has virtually doubled the length to 3.75 km.
- Back to the Hotel. overnight in Baku

DAY– 3 SHAHDAG TOUR

- Breakfast in Hotel
- Assembly at hotel lobby. Departure to SHAHDAGH (3 hours)
Start to use Shahdag activities. **The Shahdag Mountain Resort Complex** was open to the public in 2012. It is in Azerbaijan's Greater Caucasus range. The site is located near Shahdag National Park, which is known for having an intact ecological system and an untouched flora and fauna. A vast wilderness that offers an enthralling blend of adventure, serenity, and biodiversity.
- It is the first and largest ski resort in Azerbaijan. Shahdag Mountain Resort is the first and biggest ski resort located in the Gusar district near Shahdag National Park, at an altitude of 1300–2300 meters above sea level.
- Plans for the project include 4–5 Star hotels, golf clubs, 160–180 cottages, and other objects in the complex. The winter season in Shahdag begins in the second half of December and finishes at the beginning of April, depending on snow conditions. There are winter and summer activities for adults and children.

- Back to the Hotel. overnight in Baku

DAY – 4 GOBUSTAN TOUR

- Breakfast in Hotel
- The tour starts with Gobustan, which is best known for being the home to the famous rock petroglyphs. Gobustan geographical region is situated in the west-south of Baku. Gobustan National Park is a State Reserve located in the west of the settlement of Gobustan, about 40 miles southwest of the center of Baku. It was established in 1966 when the region was declared a national historical landmark of Azerbaijan, in an effort to preserve the ancient carvings, mud volcanoes, and gas stones in the region. The area has been settled since the 8th millennium BC.
- The **Bibi-Heybat Mosque** is a historical mosque in Baku, Azerbaijan. The existing structure, built in the 1990s, is a recreation of the mosque with the same name built in the 13th century by Shirvanshah Farrukhzad II Ibn Ahsitan II, which was completely destroyed by the Bolsheviks in 1936. The mosque includes the tomb of Ukeyma Khanum (a descendant of The Islamic Prophet Muhammad) and is today the spiritual center for Muslims of the region and one of the major monuments of Islamic architecture in Azerbaijan.
- Continue with **Deniz Mall**: Located on land reclaimed from the Caspian Sea, Deniz Mall is a 120,000 m² entertainment, leisure, and dining destination spread over five floors. With its unique architectural concept, it hosts brands such as: Casa Culinary Art School of Azerbaijan, Beverly Hills and Chill Box, Big Chef, TGI Friday, Dine Hall, Kinderland (first time in Azerbaijan), Starbucks, Nike, Swarovski, Pandora, Paul, Go Sport, Alma Store, LVIV Handmade Chocolate, Cinema Plus
- Back to the Hotel. overnight in Baku

DAY –5 FLAME TOUR

- Breakfast in Hotel
- The tour starts with Ateshgah (Fire Worshippers Temple). Based on Persian and Indian inscriptions, the temple was used as a Hindu and Zoroastrian place of worship. "Atash" is the Persian word for fire. The pentagonal complex, which has a courtyard surrounded by cells for monks and a tetra pillar-altar in the middle, was built during the 17th and 18th centuries.
- Trip to "Fire Mountain" – Yanar Dag – a mountain on the Absheron Peninsula, 25 km north of Baku. Literally, the word "Yanar Dag" means "Blazing Mountain". Blazing bodies of flame dance on stones and floor. Yanar Dag is a natural gas fire which blazes continuously on a hillside on the Absheron Peninsula on the Caspian Sea near Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan, which is known as the "Land of Fire."

- Ganjlik Mall – Located 10 minutes from the city center by taxi. Ganjlik Mall is the biggest mall in Baku and contains: Over 80 stores, big bowling halls, The biggest movie halls, 3D cinema, Children's playground, Bravo supermarket, VIP restaurants, Food courts
- Back to the Hotel. overnight in Baku

DAY -6 DEPARTURE

- Breakfast at the hotel, check out of the hotel.
- Transfer to Heydar Aliyev International Airport
- Departure.

E-Visa:

Passport must be valid for more than 6 months and QID must be valid for minimum 3 months after return date.
