- **The People’s House: A White House Experience** (interactive exhibits)
- The guided tour begins with the **World War II Memorial** and **Lincoln Memorial**
- Continue D.C. tour: exterior views/photo stops at the **White House** and **U.S. Capitol Building**

Afternoon

- **Smithsonian National Museum of Natural History** (gems, fossils, dinosaurs)
- Lunch: on your own

Evening

- Scenic drive to **Harrisburg, Pennsylvania**
- Indian dinner en route or on arrival; check in to the hotel

Overnight: Harrisburg



Day 5 – Harrisburg → Niagara Falls (Buffalo, NY)

Hotel: Sheraton Niagara Falls, NY (or similar)

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner



Morning:

- Visit the **Pennsylvania State Capitol** (grand dome, artwork, historic chambers).
- Continue to **Hershey's Chocolate World** (chocolate-making experience, shopping).
- Lunch on your own.

Evening:

- Journey onward to **Niagara Falls**.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Once confirmed, 25% of booking fees will be Non-refundable.
- Prior to 60 days to 45 days: 50% of the holiday amount is nonrefundable
- 44 and 30 days of departure: 75% of the holiday cost
- Less than 29 days prior to departure 100% of the total amount will be deducted.

PAYMENT POLICY

- Initial Deposit: 25% of the total package amount to reserve the seats with passport copies
- 75 % of the balance amount to be paid by: 45 days prior to travel

- **Meet and Greet is available at an additional cost of \$49 in New York Airports.**
- **Hotel check-in in New York is at 4:00 p.m. Thursday; check-out in Niagara Falls is 11:00 a.m. Wednesday.**
- **Provide your flight information as early as possible for smooth transfers.**

- Philadelphia → Washington, D.C.: approx. 3.5 hrs
- Washington, D.C. → Harrisburg: approx. 2.5 hrs

- Corning → Niagara Falls, NY: approx. 2.5 hrs
